AT NAMBOUR YANDINA FOOTBALL CLUB

NYU football club prides itself on offering opportunities for all ages, genders and abilities to play football in a safe and supportive environment. We have teams that cater for 5 years of age through to Premier Men and Women.

Nambour-Yandina United Football Club was formed in 1997; amalgamating two great earlier clubs the Nambour Reds (founded in 1974) and the Yandina Eagles (founded in 1976). Each Club brought with it their own areas of specialty, one a strong youth backgrounds and the other well established senior teams creating a perfect blend. The Club then affiliated with Sunshine Coast Football and Football Queensland.

With over 250 players registered in most age groups and across a number of divisions it is a Club that is recognized across the Sunshine Coast for not only its strength, but also its passionate supporters. Both genders and all age groups are welcome no matter their level of skill. We have players aged from 5 to 70 who compete and train on a weekly basis. All of whom learn through experience what it is to be part of a team and the value that holds.

For more than twenty years the Club has also hosted the Yandina Community Markets, visited by thousands each year, it is a valuable source of fund-raising and a huge boost each weekend to the local economy.

2024 SIGN ON/REGISTRATION

Online Registration Sign-On from - 9th of Jan 2024, Register by downloading the app called Squadi available online, through Google Play and/or the AppStore. If you don't already have a Squadi account, follow the prompts to Create Account, then hit three dots on the bottom right of your phone to Register Profile. Select or Add a Participant > + New Participant Registration and scroll down and answer the questions to register the player (yourself or child/children), full payment to be required in Squadi.

In 2023 Football QLD also required all participants to ALSO register online in Playfootball.com.au for Insurance purposes, at www.playfootball.com.au. It is still being confirmed if registration is required in both platforms for the 2024 season.

Fixtures

Nambour Yandina United FC plays in the Sunshine Coast Football Competition that is governed by Football QLD and FFA.

Football Queensland manages all fixtures for the competition for all age groups and allocates where and when your team plays.

From March 1st 2023 the new app called Squadi which is Football QLD's new management software will include fixtures, results, ladders, statistics, online team sheets, game changes, wet weather advice for cancelled games. Team communication is also built into Squadi, which can be used, similar to Messenger and Whatapp.

It is common for teams to create a private team group chat through Messenger or similar platform, to chat & stay in touch through the season. Team group chats assist with communication, carpooling and absent communications to your coach.

On game day your first point of call is your coach so please ensure you have their number or contact. Squadi the App will also be a vital source of field allocations and changes each week.





MINI ROOS UNDER 6 TO UNDER 12



MiniRoos is a nation wide initiative developed by the Football Federation Australia. It's a smaller version of football that provides boys and girls aged 5-11 with a fun introduction to the world game. MiniRoos is designed for children; it's all about having fun, learning new skills, and making lifelong friends. MiniRoos provides opportunities for boys and girls of all abilities, shapes and sizes to play football together and is non-competitive (No score recorded or competition ladder)
